

Energy Policy

The objectives of the Energy Management System Policy of **Acciai Speciali Terni S.p.A. (AST)** define commitments to manage and improve energy performance, in accordance with ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) sustainability principles.

They reflect the entrepreneurial culture of the Arvedi Group in pursuing profit in a socially responsible and ecologically compatible way, a culture that Arvedi AST shares and puts into practice through the proper management of energy resources and taking on the expectations of its Stakeholders. The commitments to sustainable energy management at Arvedi AST, therefore, are as follows:

1. **Energy efficiency, consumption reduction, climate protection and environmental protection:** through the assessment and monitoring of all energy aspects and their impacts, as well as the periodic collection and analysis of energy performance monitoring data, Arvedi AST is committed to developing improvement plans to reduce consumption, increase plant efficiency and ensure the sustainability of its activities.
2. **Sustainable development:** design and production activities are planned from a product life cycle perspective, ensuring that resource consumption and impact on the environment are always minimized. To this end, best available equipment, techniques and technologies are used to prevent waste.
3. **Risk Based Thinking and Continuous Monitoring:** context analysis to identify potential energy risks and the adoption of continuous monitoring tools enable the coordination of preventive measures to mitigate risk factors associated with improper procurement.
4. **Compliance with legal requirements:** the Energy Management System ensures, through the appropriate tools for continuous updating, compliance with current legislation, signed voluntary regulations, company requirements and provisions.
5. **Competence and awareness:** to ensure an effective system, human resources are made aware of the effects that the energy consumption of their tasks has on the business organization. Suppliers and contractors are appropriately qualified and made aware of the continuous efficiency of energy performance.
6. **Communication:** to ensure transparency and sharing of energy issues, appropriate communication is ensured to all Interested Parties, including other Arvedi Group companies.
7. **Continuous improvement:** based on data collected and analyzed at regular intervals, audit outcomes, risk assessments and operational control activities, Arvedi AST promotes continuous improvement plans to ensure effectiveness and efficiency of the Energy Management System.
