

Information to our customers concerning**Proposition 65**

Acciai Speciali Terni S.p.A. produces many stainless steel grades. These steels produced by Acciai Speciali Terni S.p.A contain or can contain chemicals listed on **California's Safe Drinking Water & Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986**. This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65, establishes a list of chemicals which the state of California's risk assessment process has determined to present a risk of cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

Chemical exposure typically occurs through inhalation, ingestion and/or absorption. Our products are not intended to be eaten or inhaled and will not be absorbed through the skin under normal conditions. Nickel and Chromium (not in hexavalent form) are elements in stainless steel that are in their stable metallic form. Products from dining ware, coins and cutlery to surgical appliances such as braces are produced from stainless steel. The materials as provided are not inherently dangerous; however, certain actions and processes, such as welding, melting, grinding, etc., may produce gases or powders and release these components, presenting a danger. Appropriate precautions should be taken to safeguard oneself and those nearby against direct contact with smoke, powder/dust, etc.

Acciai Speciali Terni S.p.A. cannot foresee all the ways our products may be used (both intended and unintended) and to what extent this may create an exposure risk.

Acciai Speciali Terni S.p.A. therefore advises that some items and products containing their own steels and exported to California must be equipped with the label below reported:
